Build a Mutant:

Create a mutant person, animal, or plant. Your mutant must be realistic to the novel. You must produce a 3-D project (drawings are not acceptable). You must include a minimum one page Inspector's Report. It should include:

Where and how it was detected

In what way it goes against the teachings of *Nicholson's Repentances*

The Inspector's ruling regarding what will happen to it (and to anyone found guilty of harbouring it)

An overall comment about your creation

PART A:

Draw and label the parts of the mutant you are going to build on the back of this sheet. This is a draft, but it should be neat and easy to understand.

PART B:

Build the mutant according to your design.

PART C:

Prepare a short presentation of your mutant for the class. All bullet points must be covered in this presentation.

PART D:

Attach a written copy of your explanations/presentation to the rubric to be submitted when you present.
